SIGHTSEEING ITINERARY
Camino de Santiago: A Walking Pilgrimage from
Sarria to Santiago de Compostela
April 2 – 10, 2027

Day 1: Friday, April 2 - Depart

Depart the USA

Day 2: Saturday, April 3– Arrive Madrid

D

Arrive in Madrid and self-transfer to your accommodations. This evening, enjoy a festive welcome dinner at one of Madrid's best traditional tapas restaurants.

Day 3: Sunday, April 4 – Madrid to Sarria

B, D

Highlights:

- Morning walking tour of Madrid.
- Train to Sarria (4 hrs.)
- Free-time to explore Sarria before local dinner.

Day 4: Monday, April 5 – Camino Day 1- Sarria → Portomarín (23 km)

B, D

Start mid-morning after a relaxed breakfast and Camino orientation. Walk through forests, small villages and very authentic Galician landscapes.

Day 5: Tuesday, April 6 – Camino Day 2 - Portomarín → Palas de Rei (25 km)

B, D

A scenic day through rolling farmland and historic sites.

Day 6: Wednesday, April 7 - Camino Day 3 - Palas de Rei to Arzúa (24 kms)

B, D

Pass through ancient villages, Romanesque churches, and peaceful woodland trails. Cross medieval bridges like Ponte Velha and enjoy local cheeses and cuisine in Arzúa, renowned for its dairy products.

Day 7: Thursday, April 8 – Camino Day 4 - Arzúa → O Pedrouzo (20 km)**B, D**

A lighter day designed to recharge through eucalyptus forests and countryside paths.

Day 8: Friday, April 9 – Camino Day 5 - O Pedrouzo → Santiago de Compostela (19 km)**B, D**

Start early for a meaningful arrival into Santiago de Compostela Cathedral.

- Group entry into the cathedral square - Attend Pilgrim's Mass
- Celebratory dinner in Santiago de Compostela

Day 9: Saturday, April 10 - Depart

Check-out and self-transfer to the airport.

\$5,840 per person – Based on 4 – 6 participants

\$5,490 per person – Based on 7 – 10 participants

\$5,140 per person – Based on 11 – 15 participants

Program Terms:

Inclusions: 7 nights' hotel accommodations; Breakfast and dinner daily; All coaching as deemed necessary; Entrance fees to all sites in the itinerary; Expert English-speaking guide throughout; Luggage transfer during all stages - 1 bag per person (max. 15 kg); Full Camino documentation pack - Dossier and practical materials including Official Pilgrim Credential; Travel insurance, including hiking activity coverage.

Exclusions: International airfare; Passport/visa expenses; Medical expenses and immunizations; Private transfers and transfers outside of group arrival and departure days; Optional excursions or deviations from the scheduled tour; Excess baggage charges; Meals not specified in the itinerary; Other items of a personal nature; Customary tips for drivers, guides, and hotel staff.

Payments: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to reserve your space and is payable by Visa, MasterCard, or check made payable to Winding Way Travel. Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure and by check, ACH transfer, or wire transfer only. Credit cards are subject to a 3% processing fee.

Participant Cancellation Fees: All participant requests for cancellations must be received in writing. Cancellations up to 91 days prior to departure are refunded less a cancellation fee of \$100 per person. After 90 days, any payments are non-refundable. Participants are strongly encouraged to purchase trip cancellation insurance for this and other reasons. Information will be provided with confirmation of receipt of your deposit.

Prices quoted are based on group participation, and no refunds will be made for any part of the program in which you choose not to participate. It is understood that refunds cannot be made to passengers who do not complete the tour for whatever reason.
